General Agreement to Promote Cultural and Scientific Cooperation between Sapienza Università di Roma

and


The Trustees of Columbia University in the City of New York

In recognition of their common interest in promoting research and education in law, la Sapienza Università di Roma ("Sapienza") and the Trustees of Columbia University in the City of New York ("Columbia") enter into this Agreement to establish a framework for promoting academic exchanges and scholarly collaboration in that field.

1. Subject to the availability of funding and the appropriate approvals at both institutions, Sapienza and Columbia agree to work to develop joint programs of mutual benefit in the following areas:
 - a. Collaborative research, joint symposia and lectures
 - b. Exchange of scholars to promote collaborative research
 - c. Exchange of information and academic materials
 - d. Exchange of undergraduate/graduate students
2. Sapienza and Columbia will separately negotiate the arrangements for each program developed under this agreement. No program will begin until the two universities have signed a written agreement that specifies its purpose, organization, financing, administration and duration. Such agreements will also specify the respective responsibilities of the two universities for the program's activities and financing.
3. This Agreement will take effect once it is signed by both parties and will continue for an initial period of five years. It may be renewed for further terms of five years on the same terms and conditions by the mutual written agreement of the two universities at least sixty days prior to its expiration. It may be amended at any time by written agreement between the two universities. Either university may cancel the Agreement by providing one-year written notice.


