Dear Professor Paciullo,

On behalf of the Director-General, I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 26 May 2017, by which you request the renewal of the Agreement between UNESCO, the University for Foreigners of Perugia and the University of Rome "La Sapienza", concerning the UNESCO Chair on Water Resources Management and Culture established in June 2013.

In light of the very good results achieved by the Chair, confirmed by the positive report on the evaluation of its activities, I am pleased to inform you that UNESCO agrees to renew the above-mentioned Agreement for an additional period of four years, until June 2021. I trust that the UNESCO Chair will strengthen its collaboration with UNESCO, and with relevant UNESCO Chairs, in particular with regards to the implementation of the UNESCO International Hydrological Programme Strategy (IHP VIII) and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

This UNESCO Chair is renewed for a period of four years. Should the Universities wish to pursue the activities of the Chair beyond this renewed period, a formal request to renew the validity of the Agreement must be addressed to UNESCO six months before the expiry date of the new Agreement. The decision to renew a Chair's Agreement is based, on the positive evaluation of the reports on the activities carried out by the Chair.


