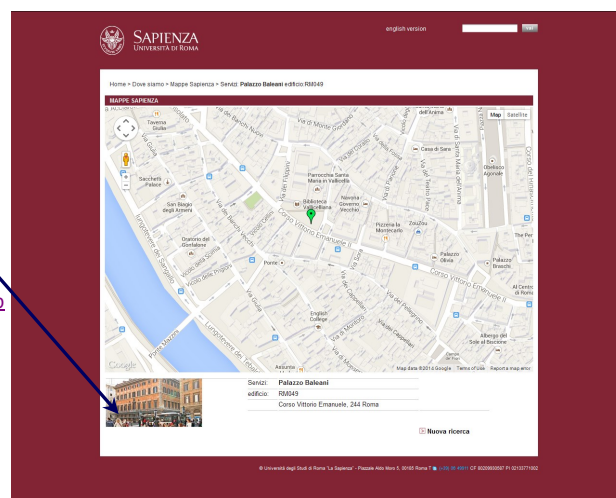

### "New H2CU headquarter at Palazzo Baleani"

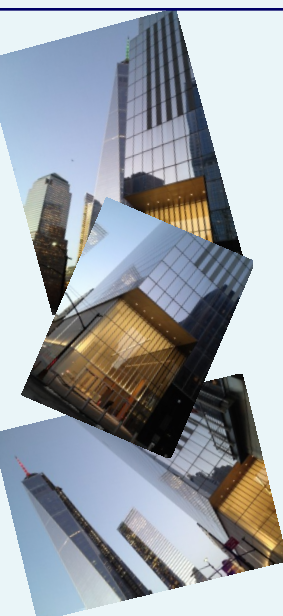
