H2CU Student's Corner: Agostino Board

thanks to Marco Daldoss

Marco Daldoss, a student of University of Brescia, won the first prize at the "Innovation Design Contest 2014" with the project "Agostino Board", an energy harvesting framework for Wireless Sensor Network. The contest has been organized by "Selezione di Elettronica", one of the most relevant magazine in the field of electronics funded in 1957. The contest, at the second edition and supported by "Politecnico di Milano", has the aim to encourage new graduated student to build up their talent and creativity, seeking and awarding excellence designs either on-chip and off-chip. Last October Marco, with the support of prof. Vittorio Ferrari and Anna Richelli, presented this thesis project and graduated full marks at the University of Brescia. The project has been directly supervised by prof. Kinget and developed in the Computer Integrated System Laboratory, at Columbia University in New York City. Agostino Board can be connected to various sensors (such as temperature or humidity) and, with the help of a solar cell, can work without the need to replace the battery, just with the energy harvested in an typical indoor environment. The device can find several application in domestic, environmental and biomedical monitoring. Following with this recent accomplishment, Marco has been invited to visit a research center in Texas the incoming April. Marco Daldoss a student from University of Brescia in the past year has been a visiting student at Columbia University where he has worked on the research for his Laurea Magistrale Theses. Marco is one of the students that has participated at the project College Italia."
